**MONMOUTH COUNTY PARK SYSTEM PLANS
9-11 MUSEUM & MEMORIAL VISIT BUS TRIP**

LINCROFT — On Saturday, April 21, the Monmouth County Park System is hosting a **9-11 Museum & Memorial Visit** bus trip. Visit this museum which honors the nearly 3,000 victims of the World Trade Center attacks and those who risked their lives to save others. See its growing permanent collection of artifacts, stories, photos, videos and other materials. Afterwards, enjoy time for lunch and to explore other points of interest in Lower Manhattan such as the Freedom Tower, a self-guided tour of St. Paul's Chapel or Federal Hall. (Please note that reservations are suggested in advance for the Freedom Tower.) The bus leaves at 8:30 a.m. from Thompson Park, 805 Newman Springs Road, Lincroft, and will return at approximately 6 p.m. The cost of the trip is \$68 per person and includes group reservations for the museum and memorial, Park System volunteer leader and round trip motor coach transportation. Pre-registration is required.
