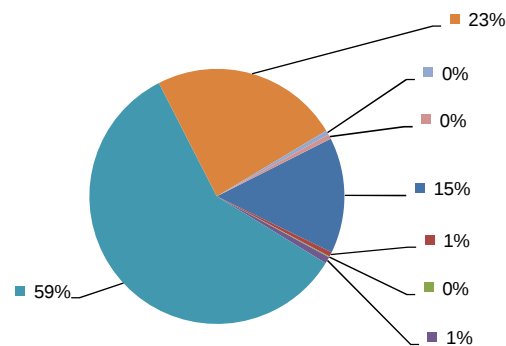
TOTAL ASSESSED TO EQUALIZED VALUE
