Modern Engine Company Tactics

(16 hours)

The most basic unit of the Fire Service is the Engine Company. The decisions made by the initial arriving Engine Companies set the stage for safety, efficiency, and overall success. With changes in construction, fuel loading, air track within structures, and fire dynamics, these decisions in the first few minutes are critical to the Incident Commander's strategies. This class has been designed to provide today's Engine Company members with the knowledge, skills, and abilities for functional competency on the emergency scene. Topics will include Incident Priorities; Modern Fire Behavior considerations; Windshield and 360° Size-up; Modes of attack for specific occupancies; Coordination of ventilation and Anti-Ventilation considerations; Tactical considerations for variables in occupancy; and will include hands-on suppression activities to reinforce course information.
