



## IS-1119: Letters of Map Amendment (LOMAs) and Letters of Map Revision-Based on Fill (LOMR-Fs)

### Course Dates:

### Course Length:

The overall time to complete the course will vary for each individual. IS-1119 takes approximately 3 hours.

### Course Description:

The purpose of this course is to provide information to individuals interested in Letters of Map Change (LOMCs) with a focus on Conditional Letters of Map Amendment (CLOMAs); Letters of Map Amendment (LOMAs); Conditional Letters of Map Revision—Based on Fill (CLOMR-Fs); and Letters of Map Revision—Based on Fill (LOMR-Fs) on the applicant, community floodplain administrator, licensed professional, and FEMA levels.

### Course Goal:

Upon completing this course, the participant will be able to describe how to:

1. Explain basic purpose and procedures of CLOMAs, LOMAs, CLOMR-Fs, and LOMR-Fs.
2. Describe roles and responsibilities in the LOMC process.
3. Understand the floodplain management and insurance implications of CLOMAs, LOMAs, CLOMR-Fs, and LOMR-Fs.
