

**Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the  
MONMOUTH COUNTY  
STORMWATER TECHNICAL ADVISORY  
COMMITTEE**

**Wednesday, May 5, 2021, 9:30 AM

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**1. CALL TO ORDER:**

Mr. Casagrande called the meeting to order at 9:36 a.m.

**2. COMPLIANCE STATEMENT:** Open Public Meetings Act

Attorney Aikins offered a statement that the meeting was being held in compliance with P.L. 1975, c.231, the Open Public Meetings Act. She further noted that supplemental notice of remote participation in the meeting via Webex internet conference and telephonic conference was given in accordance with the guidelines established by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs.

**4. Regular Reports:**

A. Staff/Pre-Adoption Review Subcommittee- Ms. Mallm reported that overall, they have approved 43 ordinances with one being conditionally approved. However, the Borough of Roosevelt did make the corrections that were requested, and according to the rules, this is now considered approved. Ms. Mallm stated that the four ordinances under review for discussion at today's meeting are Fair Haven Borough; Hazlet Township; Brielle Brough; Monmouth Beach Borough. Ms. Mallm stated that after today's meeting, they will have five remaining ordinances to review. Ms. Mallm reported that she was in touch with the remaining towns, and they are in the process of preparing their ordinances. Ms. Mallm noted that there were no updates on the Pre-Adoption Review Subcommittee, and no updates on legislation. The next scheduled meeting date is June 2, 2021.

**5. REVIEW OF MINUTES**

The minutes of the April 7, 2021 meeting were reviewed. Mr. Hill moved to adopt the minutes and Ms. Morrissey seconded the motion. Mr. Casagrande abstained. Minutes were approved by voice vote.

**7. NEW BUSINESS**

1. Borough of Fair – Ms. Mallm stated that the ordinance is consistent with NJDEP model. Mr. Barris made a motion to recommend to the Monmouth County Planning Board approval of the Borough of Fair Haven Stormwater Control Ordinance. Ms. Morrissey seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
2. Township of Hazlet - Ms. Mallm stated that the ordinance is consistent with NJDEP model. Mr. Barris made a motion to recommend to the Monmouth County Planning Board to approve the Township of Hazlet Stormwater Control Ordinance. Mr. Hill seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
3. Borough of Brielle – Ms. Mallm stated that the ordinance is consistent with NJDEP model, however, they did not remove some of the italic interpretive statements from the NJDEP, as seen in italics on p.4, p.7, & the bottom of p.13. Ms. Mallm noted that these are minor typographical errors, and it should not warrant a conditional approval. Ms. Morrissey made a motion to recommend to the Monmouth County Planning Board to approve the Borough of Brielle Stormwater Control Ordinance. Mr. Barris seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
4. Borough of Monmouth Beach – Ms. Mallm stated that the ordinance is consistent with NJDEP model except for one area. Page 7 of the ordinance includes an additional definition for redevelopment. Ms. Mallm explained that this definition is also seen in the Colts Neck and Eatontown ordinances which were previously approved. Mr. Barris made a motion to recommend to the Monmouth County Planning Board to approve the Borough of Monmouth Beach Stormwater Control Ordinance. Ms. Morrissey seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
