NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD
ON SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE MONMOUTH COUNTY
FY2021 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

The Monmouth County Office of Community Development is proposing to amend its FY2021 One-Year Annual Action Plan component of the 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan. Monmouth County expects to submit the Substantial Amendment to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on or before June 10, 2021.

The Monmouth County Annual Action Plan identifies the needs of homeless, low-income, and special needs populations and describes grant funded activities to address the priorities and specific objectives for housing and community development. Monmouth County's FY2021 Community Development Block Grant allocation has been increased. This Substantial Amendment allocates the additional CDBG funds to administration, one existing and one new project. Details of the new project and funding amounts are provided in the amendment. The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development issued a waiver 5/12/2021 lowering the public comment period requirement from 30 days to no less than 3 days. The public comment period will begin at midnight on Saturday May 22, 2021 and conclude on Tuesday May 25, 2021. The County will accept comments from the public on this Amendment during this timeframe.
