

NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD  
ON SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENTS TO THE  
FY2021 & FY2022 MONMOUTH COUNTY ANNUAL ACTION PLANS

The Monmouth County Office of Community Development is proposing substantial amendments to the FY2021 and FY2022 Components of the 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan. Monmouth County expects to submit the Substantial Amendments to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on or before July 1, 2024. The County's Annual Action Plan identifies the needs of homeless, low income and special needs populations, and describes activities the consortium intends to undertake to address the identified priorities for housing and community development. In addition, the Plans list the public and private funding sources that will be used to carry out the needs and objectives outlined in the Plans. The FY2021 Substantial Amendment allocates remaining CDBG funds from a completed municipal project to two nonprofit organizations. The FY2022 Substantial Amendment transfers unexpended administrative funds to one existing project and two additional nonprofit organizations. Details of the new projects and funding amounts are provided in the amendment documents.

The Monmouth County Citizen Participation Plan (CPP) requires a 30-day public comment period on substantial amendments to the Annual Action Plan that exceed a 25% change in allocation. The 30-day public comment period will start on May 22, 2024, and end at midnight June 21, 2024.
