

NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD  
ON SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENTS TO THE  
FY 2014 and FY2019 MONMOUTH COUNTY ANNUAL ACTION PLANS

The Monmouth County Office of Community Development is proposing one amendment to its FY 2014 Annual Action Plan Component of its 2010-2014 Consolidated Plan, and two amendments to its FY2019 Action Plan Component of the 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan. Monmouth County expects to submit the Substantial Amendments to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on or before May 1, 2021. The County's Annual Action Plans identify the needs of homeless, low income and special needs populations, and describes activities the consortium intends to undertake to address the priorities and specific objectives for housing and community development. In addition, the Plans identify the public and private funding sources that will be used to carry out the needs and objectives outlined in the Plans. The FY2014 Substantial Amendment transfers remaining CDBG funds from a completed project to one existing CDBG project. One FY2019 Substantial Amendment transfers unexpended Rapid Rehousing ESG funds to 1 new and 1 existing Emergency Solutions Grant project. The second FY2019 Substantial Amendment allocates remaining CDBG administrative funds to one existing CDBG project who has expended all previously allocated funds. Details of the new projects and funding amounts are provided in the amendments.

The Monmouth County Citizen Participation Plan (CPP) requires a 30 day public comment period on substantial amendments to the FY2014 Annual Action Plan. The 30 day public comment period will start at midnight January 29, 2021 and end at midnight March 1, 2021. To expedite expenditures of FY2019 funds due to the COVID-19 pandemic HUD Guidance issued March 30, 2020, lowered public comment requirements for eligible substantial amendments to the FY2019 Annual Action Plan to no less than 5 days. The seven day public comment period for the two proposed Substantial Amendments to the FY2019 Annual Action Plan will start on Friday January 29, 2021 and continue on and include Thursday February 4, 2021.
