NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD  
ON SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE MONMOUTH COUNTY  
FY2018 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

The Monmouth County Office of Community Development is proposing to amend its FY2018 One-Year Annual Action Plan component of the 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan. Monmouth County expects to submit the Substantial Amendment to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on or before July 31, 2021.

The Monmouth County Annual Action Plan identifies the needs of homeless, low-income, and special needs populations and describes activities the consortium intends to undertake to address the priorities and specific objectives for housing and community development. Additionally, this Plan identifies the public and private funding sources that will be used to carry out the needs and objectives outlined in the Plan. This FY2018 Substantial Amendment transfers remaining Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to one existing CDBG project and two new CDBG projects. Details of the new projects and funding amounts are provided in the amendments. The Monmouth County Citizen Participation Plan (CPP) requires a 30 day public comment period which will start at midnight April 5, 2021 and continue through and include May 5, 2021
