

**Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the
MONMOUTH COUNTY
STORMWATER TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

**Wednesday, January 6, 2021, 9:30 AM
Virtual Meeting via Webex**

1. CALL TO ORDER:

Chair Casagrande called the meeting to order at 9:34 a.m.

2. COMPLIANCE STATEMENT: Open Public Meetings Act

Attorney Aikins offered a statement that the meeting was being held in compliance with P.L. 1975, c.231, the Open Public Meetings Act.

4. REGULAR REPORTS:

A. Staff/Pre-Adoption Review Subcommittee- Ms. Mallm stated that we have not received any stormwater management plans; we are only dealing with stormwater control ordinances. Ms. Mallm reported that the Little Silver Control Ordinance was approved at the December Planning Board meeting. Today, we will be discussing Deal, Spring Lake, Ocean Township, Neptune, and Farmingdale stormwater control ordinances. In addition, an ordinance was received from Interlaken, and that will be discussed at the February meeting.

Ms. Mallm reported that the Pre-Adoption Review Subcommittee met in December, and discussed Red Bank, Long Branch, Marlboro and Atlantic Highlands Ordinances. The Red Bank and Long Branch ordinances are consistent with the NJDEP model and they both anticipate defining major development as 0.5 acres or more. Marlboro and Atlantic Highlands SCOs are also consistent with the NJDEP model.

Ms. Mallm stated that there is no update on legislation. The next anticipated meeting is scheduled for February 3, 2021.

5. REVIEW OF MINUTES

The minutes of the December 2, 2020 meeting were reviewed. Ms. Brennen moved to approve the minutes and Ms. Morrissey seconded the motion. Minutes were approved by voice vote.

6. OLD BUSINESS

7. NEW BUSINESS

Present at today's meeting Turner Shell from Leon S. Avakian.

Ms. Mallm stated that all of the ordinances present today have been prepared by Leon S. Avakian. On review, all of them are following the NJDEP model, and they correctly changed the areas where the terminology "basin" should replace "BMP."

- A. Ms. Brennen made a motion to recommend to the Monmouth County Planning Board approval of the Borough of Deal Stormwater Control Ordinance, seconded by Mr. Barris. Motion passed unanimously.
- B. Ms. Morrissey made a motion to recommend to the Monmouth County Planning Board approval of the Borough of Spring Lake Stormwater Control Ordinance, seconded by Mr. Barris. Motion passed unanimously.
- C. Mr. Poulsen made a motion to recommend to the Monmouth County Planning Board approval of the Township of Ocean Stormwater Control Ordinance, seconded by Mr. Barris. Motion passed unanimously.
- D. Ms. Brennen made a motion to recommend to the Monmouth County Planning Board approval of the Borough of Neptune City Stormwater Control Ordinance, seconded by Ms. Morrissey. Motion passed unanimously.
- E. Mr. Poulsen made a motion to recommend to the Monmouth County Planning Board approval of the Borough of Farmingdale Stormwater Control Ordinance, seconded by Ms. Brennen. Motion passed unanimously.

8. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

Mr. Shell thanked the committee, and stated that he would be back in February for Interlaken's review. Ms. Brennen suggested to Mr. Shell that any Ordinances that are being adopted in 2021 should be worded as County Commissioners and not County Board of Chosen Freeholders. Mr. Shell stated that he was going to be sure they are in compliance in that respect.
