**BOND ORDINANCE AMENDING VARIOUS BOND
ORDINANCES TO AMEND THE DESCRIPTION TO
PROVIDE FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR
AND BY THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE:

The Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Monmouth, New Jersey, has ascertained and determined to amend the Bond Ordinances set forth below, as follows:

BOND ORDINANCE 08-03

“SECTION 1:

The Bond Ordinance of the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the “Board”) entitled “BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$101,367,000 FOR VARIOUS IMPROVEMENTS AND PURPOSES FOR AND BY THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY, AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$71,055,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE COUNTY FOR FINANCING PART OF THE COST THEREOF”, finally adopted on May 22, 2008, as amended (the “Ordinance”) is hereby incorporated by reference in its entirety.

SECTION 2:

Exhibit I (1) and (2) of the Ordinance is hereby amended by (a) adding at the end thereof the additional project, “Acquisition of information technology equipment, including but not limited to computers and software, monitors, printers, copiers, video projection, scanners, phone system infrastructure, servers, network infrastructure and firewalls, recording/server cameras; Acquisition of vehicles and equipment for Recreation Commission, including but not limited to pick-up trucks, chippers, fire pump/tanks, mowers, blowers, reel mower sharpener, utility vehicles and two way radios; Various road improvements, including but not limited to Route 524/Ketcham Road (Howell) and roadway resurfacing at various other locations in the County; curbs and sidewalks, material supply contracts, landscaping, modernization of traffic signals, acquisition of rights-of-way, drainage, design and inspection, line striping, environmental mitigation at various locations in the County; materials for in-house capital projects; Bridge improvements, including but not limited to improvements in connection with County Bridges: MT-30 and MT-45 (Middletown); E-18 (Little Silver/Oceanport); F-6 (Freehold Township) and

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U-73 (Upper Freehold Township) including engineering design and inspection and general renovations; Acquisition of carpet, furniture, acoustical treatment and blinds; Various park improvements, including but not limited to roof improvements and miscellaneous renovations; and by deleting the reference of 21.73 years and 18.82 years in said section for the useful life and substituting in lieu therefor 21.66 years and 18.71 years and by (b) deleting the reference of 18.23 years for the useful life in Section 6(b) of the Ordinance and substituting in lieu therefor 18.21 years. The estimated life of said improvements is 12.17 years and the estimated cost is \$200,000.

SECTION 3:

The capital budget of the Board is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolutions in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

SECTION 4:

All other provisions of the Ordinance shall remain unchanged.

SECTION 5:

This amendatory bond ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final adoption as provided by Local Bond Law.”

The estimated life of said improvements is 12.17 years and the estimated cost is \$430,000.

The capital budget of the Board is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolutions in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk and is available there for public inspection.
