**BOND ORDINANCE REAPPROPRIATING \$1,905,000
PROCEEDS OF OBLIGATIONS NOT NEEDED FOR THEIR
ORIGINAL PURPOSES AND TO BE USED FOR ACQUISITION
OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT BY THE
COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY**

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-39, it is hereby determined that \$1,905,000 of the bond proceeds of obligations and certain other funds originally made available pursuant to the following ordinances of the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the "County") is no longer necessary for the purposes for which the obligations or funds previously were authorized. Each amount is listed under the column, "Debt Amount to be Reappropriated," and is further described by reference to the number of the bond ordinance pursuant to which such amounts have been made available, the original appropriation made by the bond ordinance, as amended, supplemented and/or cancelled, and the original description of the improvement for which such amounts were appropriated.

The \$1,905,000 bond proceeds to be reappropriated are made available as follows:
