TAKE NOTICE that the County of Monmouth has filed a request with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Green Acres Program, proposing to divert 0.851 acres of Crosswicks Creek Park in the Township of Upper Freehold in connection with the Sharon Station Road (CR 539A) Improvement Project. As compensation for the proposed diversion the County of Monmouth proposes adding 1.162 acres to the Park as replacement land.
