Directions to 4000 Kozloski Rd:

From North and Rte. 18: Take Rt. 18 south *Go five miles to Exit 22-B (Freehold/537 west) *Go 1.3 miles on Rt. 537 west following signs for Kozloski Rd...bear right *Just as you come onto the ramp for Kozloski Rd. stay to the left following sign for Kozloski Rd. south *Just before the light, move into the second lane *Cross over Rt. 537/Colts Neck Rd. *Go 0.4 mile, passing Harrington Dr. and Tuscan Rd. (on the right) Bear right just before the light indicating Burlington Rd. (This is just after the sign for the AG Building, Human Services, Police Academy) *At the bend, you'll see an entrance sign for the AG Building (this is a red brick building with bold blue trim and white overhang)

From Rt. 9 and South (Toms River, Lakewood, Howell): Take Rt. 9 North to Freehold. *Just as you approach the Freehold area, the Acme Supermarket will be on the right side. *Bear right onto Elton-Adelphia Rd. *Smith Liquors will be on the corner *Go 0.3 mile to the next traffic light *Make a left onto Halls Mill Rd. *Continue on this road (NOTE-Halls Mill Rd. turns into Kozloski Rd.) *You will pass East Freehold Park on your left and a sign for our Monmouth County Offices on your right *At the second light, make a left on Burlington Rd. *At the bend, you'll see an entrance sign for the AG Building (this is a red brick building with bold blue trim and white overhang)

John W. Tobia, Director, Public Works and Engineering

Gary Sondermeyer, Director, Technology Development, Bayshore Recycling Corp., Keasbey, NJ: this presentation will provide an overview of the Bayshore Recycling facility and operations. It highlights all the materials (with the emphasis on wood waste) that are currently accepted, processed and available for sale. It goes over the current alternative energy utilized on site and future plans for energy initiatives.

Alexander J. McCartney, Forester, Community Forestry Program, NJ Forest Service, Trenton, NJ: this talk will give a short overview of how trees planned into green infrastructure can be used to manage storm runoff, with some examples of current projects. Trees can be aimed at retaining and filtering storm water to minimize runoff during storm events. Trees with some green infrastructure changes can reduce the amount of storm water entering the system during peak flows and clean the storm water that enters the system. This may include installing rain gardens, removing impermeable surfaces and replacing with permeable surfaces, installing green strips and trees along roads and parking lots, planting in dry basin retention ponds to increase effectiveness and many more ideas.

Diane Larson, Horticulturist, Rutgers Cooperative Extension of Monmouth County, Freehold, NJ: will give a presentation on the Master Gardeners of Monmouth County - Who They Are and What They Do. Find out what it takes to become a Master Gardener, the volunteer projects they're involved in and what's happening on their Helpline. Learn how they can provide you with free plant diagnoses, soil tests and horticultural advice.

Brian Gosnell, County Helicopter Pilot and NJ Commercial Pesticide Applicator, Monmouth County Division of Shade Tree, Freehold, NJ: will give a update on the gypsy moth aerial spray program and a presentation on weed control pesticide application on county rights of way and proper safety procedures on making these applications. As well as, helpful hints for homeowners to keep weeds out of their curb line.
