Assistant Controller

Each year, NJCC provides millions of dollars in capital and substantial financial and technical assistance to support the revitalization of underserved communities across the state. These efforts provide quality housing, early care,

education, and employment to thousands of low-income people. NJCC has also emerged as a national leader in developing innovative strategies to reverse the distress created by the foreclosure crisis, implementing large-scale programs to acquire and redevelop vacant homes, modify nonperforming mortgages, and infuse flexible capital into collaborative community-level efforts to stabilize blighted neighborhoods.

Recent organizational growth requires that we expand our Finance Team to include an Assistant Controller.

Position Summary:

The Assistant Controller will report to the Controller and assist with a wide range of daily, monthly, quarterly and annual accounting and financial reporting matters. The primary responsibility of the Assistant Controller will be the timely and accurate closing of the corporate financial books on a monthly basis and preparation related financial statements and report for internal and external use.

The Assistant Controller will work closely with members of the Finance Department and other departments to insure the integrity of financial information. The ability to communicate with others, both orally and in writing, is critical

Responsibilities include:

- General Ledger account analysis
- Monthly and annual consolidation procedures
- Preparation of Financial Statements and Management Reports for multiple entities
- Preparation of standard and customized reports for investors and donors
- Assist with the development and/or revision of Financial Policies and practices
